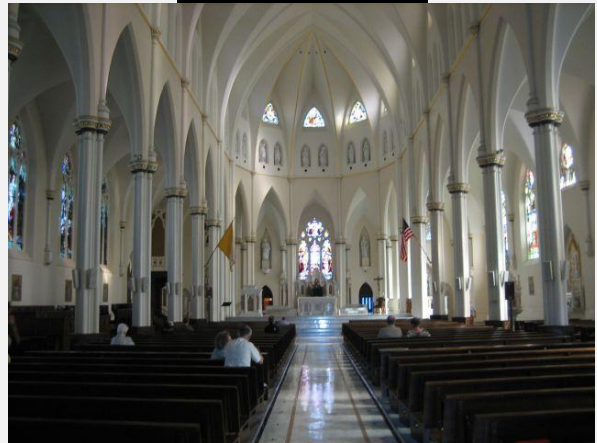
NEEDY IN OUR MIDST

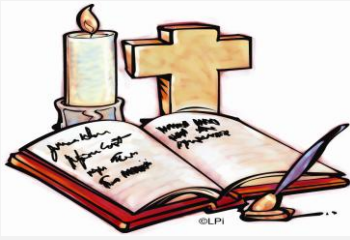

CHURCH SUPPORT

Offertory collections for Christmas Masses, New Year Masses, and the weekend Masses of December 26th – 27th, and January 2nd – 3rd, totaled \$27,755. **Thank you!** One year ago over the same time period, a total of \$38,252 was contributed.

The second collections taken at the Christmas Masses to reduce the church's debt totaled \$5,435 and last weekend's collection to assist in the cost of snow removal totaled \$2,325. Thank you for your continued support of these important collections for our parish.

At the half-way point of our fiscal year, offertory collections through December 31st have totaled \$172,195. This is \$5,455 less than over the same time period as last year and \$12,560 behind the 4% increase our finance committee used in its calculations when putting together the church's budget.

As we begin the second half of the fiscal year, an anonymous parishioner has come forward with the intent of stimulating increased contributions to our weekly offertory collections. **Each weekend that St. Joseph's offertory collection exceeds its budgeted income, the anonymous parishioner will make a donation equal to 3% of that week's budgeted offertory collection.** We wish to sincerely thank this anonymous parishioner and encourage all parishioners to contribute generously to the weekend collection, thereby, enabling us to achieve the needed budgeted offertory income.
