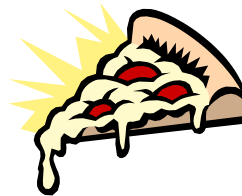

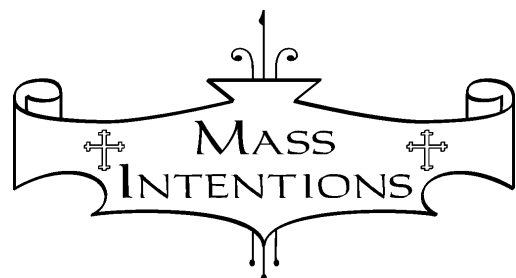
Tuesday night's Prayer Group at St. Patrick's will meet June 1<sup>st</sup> and then take a summer break. The group will resume again mid-September.

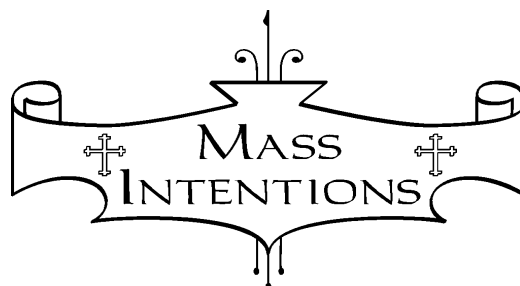

**Habitat for Humanity Spring Walk results**

Dear Interfaith Portland Walk Organizers,

What a fantastic day and result! THANK YOU, THANK YOU!

I need to sit down with more time than I have right now to give you a thorough accounting, but very quickly, it looks as if we had a minimum of 75 registered walkers, and income of \$2993 in cash today. Add this to the \$1023 already collected on line, and we have a total to date of \$4016! Plus some tee-shirt sales, donations for the food, and there is still pledged income which hasn't arrived.

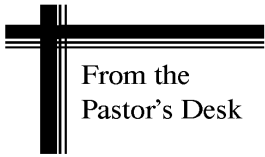
This compares with 68 walkers and income of \$3340 at the same time in 2009, and 22 walkers and \$2023 in 2008!

Well done, you guys!!! I'll have more details coming to you soon, e.g., a break-out by faith community, etc. Also, I'll be contacting you all to schedule a celebratory dinner!

In one of the Gospel readings this week, Jesus says that his followers must not lord their authority over one another but the true Christian leader, following Jesus' own example, is a servant – a servant to all. I was also reading about one of the early popes this week, Gregory the Great, who truly "ruled" the church of his day in that spirit of service. In fact, Gregory used for himself the title, "Servant of the Servants of God," a papal title still used today.

Such a model of being a Christian of course does not only apply to popes and pastors, those "in authority". Rather, being a servant to others is something each of us is called to do in hers/his own way, according to our state in life: leaders and ministers in the church, certainly, but also parents, teachers, workers, children, teenagers, the old and anyone else you can think of. Being a servant does not mean being subservient, but making our habit an openness to help and care for others around us – to be humble and patient enough, put our hands to whatever labor comes our way that will nourish others and build up our family, faith community, school and workplace. Jesus also says, "where I am, there also will my servants be". Let us work each day to be good servants and thus be with the Lord.

## Cluster 28 Transition

Summer is almost upon us! Hard to believe the year has gone by so quickly. The changes necessitated by the formal clustering of our parishes and the departure of our beloved Capuchin Friars from St. Joseph church in early August will soon begin to unfold.

On Monday, July 5, the new cluster 28 office will open on the first floor of the friary at St. Joseph. Some minor renovations will soon be underway to accommodate our needs in this regards. While I will continue to keep my office at St. Patrick's church, the other members of my Cluster leadership team, Pam Fogg and Mary Gordon will be at St. Joseph's along with the business and religious education offices. At that time Julie Cannon will become the bookkeeper for the whole Cluster and Sandy Litcher will collaborate with Pam Fogg on the religious education program. Linda McCormack will continue to serve as Cluster administrative assistant working out of her current office at St. Patrick's. At St. Pius X, we plan to provide a morning office presence several days each week. This will be especially important when the Mass schedule changes begin August 2, with the daily 9AM Mass being offered at St. Pius. Our hope is that updated computer resources and phone links will facilitate our being able to serve you well in this new configuration. For example, a single Cluster phone number will give you access to all Cluster offices/personnel in the three parishes and St. Brigid School.

At Father Peter's request, the bishop has been asked and has agreed to appoint me pastor/administrator of the Cluster as of July 1, although Fr. Peter and his Capuchin brothers will continue to reside at the Friary and provide their regular ministry to the community of St. Joseph's until their departure in early August. I continue to thank God for their patience with the process and changes this year and for the loving presence they have been for our community these many years.

Please continue to keep our community in your prayers in this time of transition.
