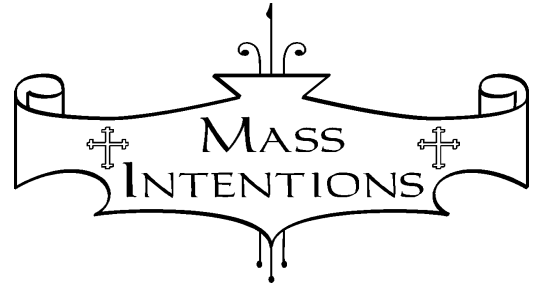

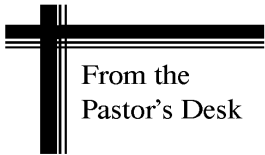

From the  
Pastor's Desk

In today's gospel, Jesus asks his disciples "Who do people say that I am?" Various answers are given--- Isaiah, Elijah, John the Baptist, or one of the other prophets returned from the dead. Then, Jesus asks his disciples: "Who do **you** say that I am?" Finally, it is Peter who declares that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. He may not have fully understood what he was saying, but he believed that Jesus was someone special.

That question is not left only to the early disciples, that question is also directed to us. Who do **we** say that Jesus is? As any person, Jesus is complex; there are many facets to his personality. Do we focus in on the infant Jesus, or Jesus the prophet and healer? However we look at Jesus, we must never forget to include Jesus on the cross and at the empty tomb on Easter Sunday. As scripture scholars have pointed out, the heart of the Gospels is the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus. The rest is prologue.

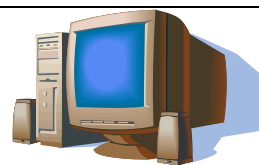
