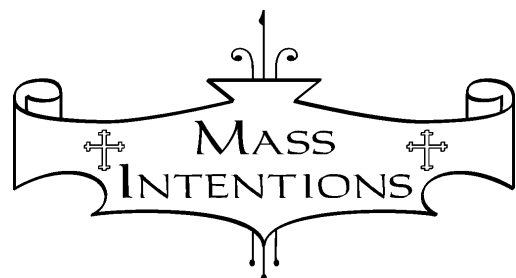

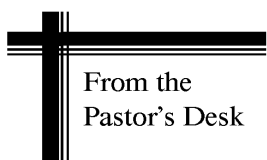

Well, it was quite a celebration! My thanks to the many, many people who attended, and special thanks to the many, many people who were involved in all aspects of the liturgy and then in preparing, cooking, decorating, and cleaning up for the delightful meal that followed. As I said in my homily, we were witnessing a miracle, the harmonious coming together of the folks of these two parishes, now one community of faith. Much to thank God for there.

I need to thank so many of you too for your warm words, notes, cards, and spiritual bouquets on this occasion, and also for a lot of wonderful gifts – jams & jellies, gourmet cheeses, breads, baked goods (Fr. Regan also thanks you for those!), and even for a Hawaiian shirt. That could give me ideas.....

Dozens of you also made generous gifts of cash and checks. Let me tell you what I am doing with those. Jesuits are men of the Church, and when we can we gladly help local churches by supplying priests in parishes like these. Over the years Jesuits have run several other parishes in Portland, Bangor, Eastport, Westbrook, Gardiner, and the two Indian reservations down east. But for the most part our men commit to two apostolates, the missions and the world of education. Here in Maine, the Jesuits' longest standing commitment has been to Cheverus High School, and we are very proud of that. Cheverus is a jewel in the city and in the church, academically, athletically and in civic service. Right now it is doing well, with strong enrollment, great courses, great facilities. One of those facilities is the new gym, which was badly needed but the cost of which has put a huge burden of debt on the school. Even as it is, Cheverus gives \$1,000,000 a year in financial aid to students who couldn't otherwise afford to attend. But if the school were out from under the debt, even more students from lower-income families could be brought in. As a Catholic school, Cheverus does not benefit from city or state funding, and as an independent school it does not receive diocesan funding either. So I am donating what you gave to me, along with a significant gift an anonymous donor has sent to increase the total amount, to Cheverus. As I do so, I invite you to reflect

gratefully as I do on how worthy a place Cheverus is in our church and our city, and perhaps to consider putting the school on your Christmas list. In doing so you'll be sharing in the blessing Cheverus is to us all.

Thanks again to everyone.
