

Strengthen within us the pursuit of justice, the desire for equality, the love of true freedom.

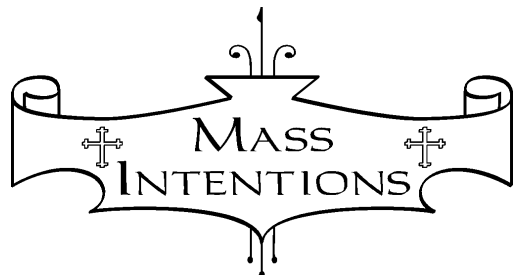
May all the citizens of our country work unceasingly to promote the common good so that all may share in the pursuit of happiness sought by the founders of our land.

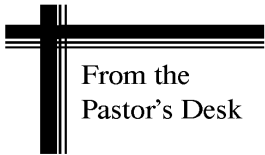

Pastor's Desk

### I hope I cry

I'm a crier. I cry when I'm happy. You know, when you laugh so hard you cry. That's me. My mom was the same way. I cry when I'm sad or when I see someone else who is sad. I don't even have to know the person or the reason they are sad. I cry when I see people treat myself or others kindly or harshly. I cry at commercials, especially Hallmark and the Seventh Day Adventists ones--those kill me. Thinking about it, I'm amazed I get through a day without crying. My brother Peter calls me the human tear duct. I used to try and 'toughen up' but it didn't work. My mother told me I was made this way for a reason and to embrace it - easier said than done.

I admit it can be embarrassing and I really wish I had more control over it than I do. My family is used to my tearing up at everything. For the most part, they don't tease me... too badly. They know what will trigger me off most of the time, though one time my son was completely baffled.

We were at Mass one Sunday and during the liturgy of the Eucharist he looked over and saw tears going down my cheek. I realized this alarmed him and gave him a smile and wink to reassure him I was okay. Following Mass he asked me what made me cry. I told him I usually tear up during that time of the Mass because of what is happening before me and inside of me. I find it overwhelming every time. And because I am now filling myself with His word daily, that time during Mass is even more potent. I actually feel I am sitting there in the upper room with Jesus and His apostles. I understand all the words He is telling His loved ones and what it **all** means. Even writing this I am washed over with emotion - with such a feeling of being loved. Of realizing how precious I am (we are) to Him. Nothing else comes close to the beauty of it. It is such a personal experience and yet we are all invited to share in it.

I hope I continue to cry.
