**Baptism:** Please call friary office.

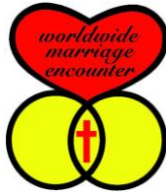
Baptism is customarily celebrated on the last Sunday of the month.

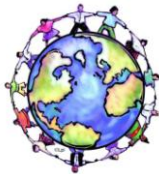

**July 14<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. Learn about the Iraqi Culture**

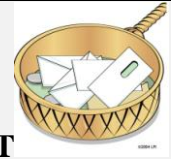
**August 4<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. Learn about the Burundi Culture**

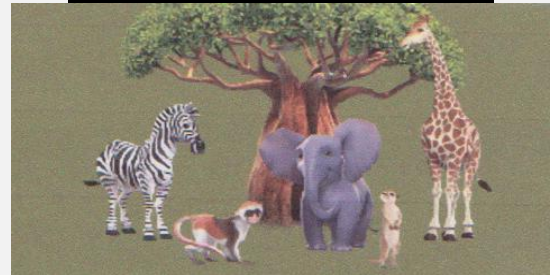


### STRENGTHENING THE HEARTBEAT OF THE CHURCH
