CCHD seeks nominations of Catholic young adult leaders addressing poverty.

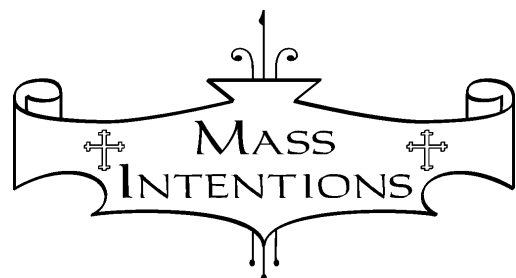

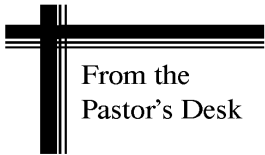

From the
Pastor's Desk

As you have probably read in the papers, the diocese has completed its capital campaign, *Strengthening the Heartbeat of the Church*. Despite the hard economic times of these past two years, the diocese exceeded the original goal of 40 million dollars by over 2 million. The success of this campaign marks an important moment for our diocese in providing us with a more secure future.

St. Patrick and St. Pius X each contributed close to \$300,000 to the campaign. Many of you have been remarkably generous, not only in your willingness to make a contribution, but also in your patience in listening to me talk about the campaign in meetings and during liturgies. Your generosity has not only helped provide for the future of our church here in Maine, it will directly benefit our parishes as well. Twenty-five percent of the money our parishioners contributed will come directly back to the parishes over the course of the next five years – \$75,000 for each parish. This revenue will help us attend to deferred maintenance needs in our aging buildings – roofs and boilers and whatnot – work we are often hard pressed to fund out of our regular collections.

My thanks to those who helped out over and above in making phone calls and appointments for me, running meetings, participating in phone-a-thons. I am especially grateful to Janet Burns, Mary Gordon, Ted Borduas and Linda McCormack. My deepest gratitude to all parishioners for your gifts and your prayers these past three months while the campaign was going on in our parishes. We would never have done so well without the help of so many.
