Baptism is customarily celebrated on the last Sunday of the month.

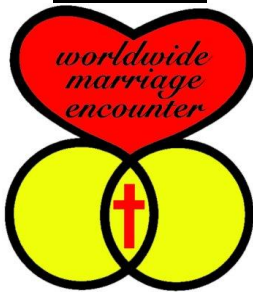
**Marriage:** Couples should contact the friary office at least 6 months in advance.

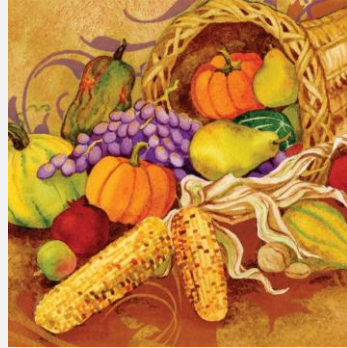

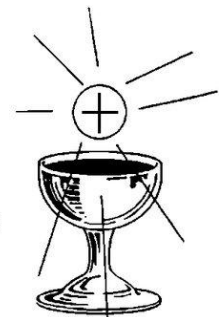
Dance to the music of The Tony Boffa Band and get in on the fun of our silent auction. Social hour begins at 7:00 p.m., with dinner and dancing to follow.
