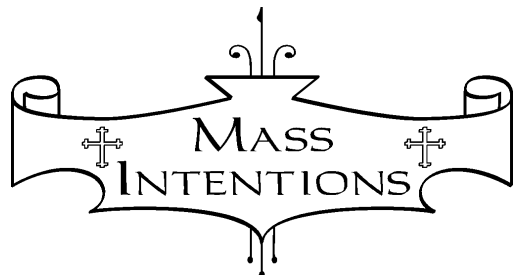

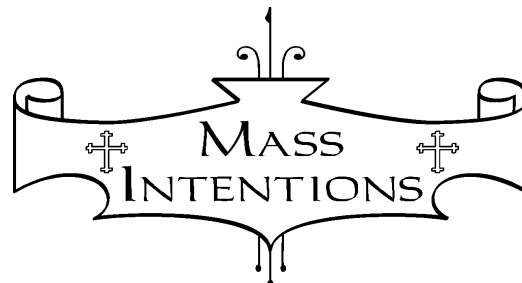

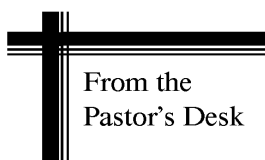

### Dear Father

Jesus prayed often. There were times when he wanted nothing more than to be alone, away from the apostles. There was nothing he had to ask of the Father but to be in his presence. One day someone asked Jesus, "Lord, teach us how to pray." The prayer he gave them was NOT to be recited as it was to be mediated on, phrase by phrase. It was a prayer intended to nourish the apostles from within and transform them. A prayer that would unite them with the Father. Only Jesus knew the Father intimately.

Jesus tells us there is no limit to God's generosity. He tells us that our desires are limited only by our fears, our prayers by our weakness, and our achievements by our lack of faith.

The obstacle to having our prayers answered is not the difficulty of getting God to listen to them, but the difficulty of getting ourselves to pray with faith. We must persevere in prayer, not to wear down the Father's resistance to giving, but to wear down our persistence to taking (receiving).
