Baptism: Please call friary office.

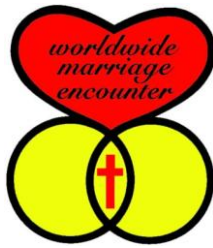
Baptism is customarily celebrated on the last Sunday of the month.
